Title: Nurse Practitioner

Reports to: Chief Operating Officer with medical direction from Chief Medical Officer

Summary: The Nurse Practitioner provides primary care in the clinic and medical van settings including the full range of medical services.

Responsibilities:

- Demonstrates satisfactory knowledge and clinical judgment to provide primary care for patients.
- Performs comprehensive medical evaluations for patients
- Performs general physical examination as indicated and instructs patients in health promotion and disease prevention.
- Obtains appropriate specimens as indicated and performs testing as indicated.
- Examines patients to determine presence of disease, utilizing physical findings, laboratory results, medical history, ascertains nature and extent of disease and prescribes treatments as indicated.
- Develops and institutes appropriate treatment plans per protocol with the consultation of physician supervisor.
- Treatment will include the care of acute and chronic medical problems.
- Participates as an active member of the primary care and behavioral health team alongside physicians, psychiatrist, behavioral health counselors, nurses, and medical assistants.
- Participates in the development of protocols.
- Participates in continuing education courses, in-services and staff meetings.
- Acts as medical resource for staff information; assists with training of medical, outreach and case management staff.
- Participates in quality assurance activities as assigned.
